



Exposed shores. Narrow zone, showing white, on upper shore.




Acorn Barnacle Chthamalus montagui IDENTIFICATION: Aperture kite-shaped. Side plates **S** overlap rostral plate **R**.




Acorn Barnacle Semibalanus balanoides
